- 2-3 behavioral objectives (i.e., what will the attendee learn? Use words that begin with “describe,” “identify,” “define,” “list,” etc.)
- Abstract (700 word limit)
- Recent references/supporting research (dated from 2013 to 2019)
- Current CV
- Previous speaking experience, to include references and evaluations (if possible)
